<p>WAC: 170-296-0790 Tobacco</p> <p>Is smoking permitted around children?</p> <p>(1) You must prohibit smoking in your family home child care during all hours of operation (licensed or unlicensed space), and in motor vehicles while transporting children.</p> <p>(2) You may permit adults to smoke outdoors in unlicensed space and out of view of children.</p>	<p>170-296A-4050 No smoking. (1) As required by chapter 70.160 RCW, the licensee must, under the following conditions, prohibit smoking by anyone during operating hours:</p> <p>(a) Inside the home;</p> <p>(b) In any outdoor or indoor licensed space;</p> <p>(c) Within twenty-five feet from any entrance, exit, window, or ventilation intake of the home; or</p> <p>(d) In motor vehicles while transporting children.</p> <p>[50] OTS-3651.5</p> <p>(2) The licensee must keep tobacco products, cigarettes and containers holding cigarette butts, cigar butts, or ashes inaccessible to the children.</p>	<p>Life Threatening: Long term affects of second hand smoke.</p> <p>Cost: None</p> <p>Regulation Consideration: Observation and inquiry during site visit.</p> <p>WAC Alignment: RCW 70.160.020 Residence used for licensed child care defined as —public place.</p> <p>70.160.030 Smoking in public places prohibited.</p> <p>(2) "Public place" means that portion of any building or vehicle used by and open to the public, regardless of whether the building or vehicle is owned in whole or in part by private persons or entities, the state of Washington, or other public entity, and regardless of whether a fee is charged for admission, and includes a presumptively reasonable minimum distance, as set forth in RCW 70.160.075, of twenty-five feet from entrances, exits, windows that open, and ventilation intakes that serve an enclosed area where smoking is prohibited.
